MODERN VERSIONS EXALT PRIDE

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God hates pride

The King James Bible never says that pride is good. Pride says “my way, not God’s way”.



There is no such thing as *good pride*.

God does not say that He is 'proud'

“And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am **well pleased.**” (Matthew 3:17)

God does not use the word 'proud' to describe Himself

- Bible believers should remove pride from their language.
- Modern versions, however, promote pride as being acceptable at certain times.

God does not use the word 'proud' to describe our sacrifices

“But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is **well pleased.**” (Hebrews 13:16)

The proud do not seek God

“The wicked, through the **pride of his countenance**, will not seek *after God*: God is not in all his thoughts.” (Psalm 10:4)

God hates pride

“The fear of the LORD *is* to hate evil: **pride**, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, **do I hate.**” (Prov. 8:13)

Pride brings contention

“Only by **pride cometh contention**: but with the well advised *is wisdom.*” (Prov. 13:10)



The proud will be punished

“Every one that is **proud in heart** *is an abomination* to the LORD: *though* hand *join* in hand, he shall not be unpunished.” (Prov. 16:5)

Pride leads to destruction

“*Pride goeth before destruction*, and an haughty spirit before a fall.” (Prov. 16:18)

Fools speak pridefully

“In the mouth of the foolish *is* a **rod of pride**:
but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.”
(Prov. 14:3)

Rejection of God is the essence of pride

“For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the **pride of life**, is not of the Father, but is of the world.”

(1 John 2:16)

Pride defiles a person

“Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, **pride**, foolishness: All these **evil things** come from within, and **defile** the man.” (Mark 7:22, 23)

Modern versions teach that children should
have pride!

“Children’s children are a crown to the aged,
and **parents are the pride** of their children.”
(Prov. 17:6 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“Children's children *are* the crown of old men;
and the **glory of children** *are* their fathers.”
(Prov. 17:6 KJB)

Modern versions make Paul prideful!

“I am talking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, **I take pride** in my ministry” (Romans 11:13 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I **magnify** mine office” (Romans 11:13 KJB)

Modern versions encourage readers to be
prideful

“We are not trying to commend
ourselves to you again, but are giving you
an opportunity to **take pride in us**, so that
you can answer those who take pride in
what is seen rather than in what is in the
heart.” (2 Corinthians 5:12 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to **glory** on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to *answer* them which glory in appearance, and not in heart.”
(2 Corinthians 5:12 KJB)

Modern versions teach people to take pride in each other

“I have spoken to you with great frankness; **I take great pride in you.** I am greatly encouraged; in all our troubles my joy knows no bounds.” (2 Corinthians 7:4 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“Great *is* my boldness of speech toward you, great *is* my **glorying** of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.” (2 Corinthians 7:4 KJB)

Pride is a desired quality in modern versions

“Therefore show these men the proof of your love and the reason for **our pride in you**, so that the churches can see it.”
(2 Corinthians 8:24 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“Wherefore shew ye to them, and before the churches, the proof of your love, and of our **boasting** on your behalf.”
(2 Corinthians 8:24 KJB)

Modern versions claim pride is to be sought
after

“Each one should test their own actions.
Then they can **take pride in themselves**
alone, without comparing themselves to
someone else” (Galatians 6:4 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“But let every man prove his own work,
and then shall he have **rejoicing in himself**
alone, and not in another.”
(Galatians 6:4 KJB)

Modern versions claim both believers and unbelievers should take pride

“Believers in humble circumstances ought to take **pride in their high position**. But the rich should **take pride in their humiliation**—since they will pass away like a wild flower.”

(James 1:9, 10 NIV)

The true Bible says...

“Let the brother of low degree **rejoice** in that he is exalted: But the rich, in that he is made low: because as the flower of the grass he shall pass away.” (James 1:9, 10 KJB)

Modern versions claim believers should have
pride in Christ

“We are the ones who are truly circumcised.
We worship God through his Spirit, and **our
pride is in Christ Jesus.**”

(Philippians 3:3 New Century Version)

The true Bible says...

“For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and **rejoice in Christ Jesus**, and have no confidence in the flesh.” (Philippians 3:3 KJB)

Modern versions say believers should take
pride in each other

“You are our hope, our joy, and the crown
we will take **pride** in when our Lord Jesus
Christ comes.”

(1 Thessalonians 2:19 New Century
Version)

The true Bible says...

“For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown of **rejoicing**? *Are* not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?” (1 Thessalonians 2:19 KJB)
