

What is the nature of man?


"And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Thessalonians 5:23) "And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul" (Matthew 10:28a)



Why is it important to know about the soul?

The soul must prosper for us to prosper in God. "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, <u>even as thy</u> soul prospereth." (3 John 2)

"Bless the LORD, O my <u>soul</u>: and all that is <u>within me</u>, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and <u>forget not all his benefits</u>" (Psalm 103:1,2)



How does the Bible use the word 'soul'?

- The Bible uses the word 'soul' in 2 ways:
- In reference to the <u>whole person</u>, such as "Then sent Joseph, and called his father Jacob to him, and all his kindred, threescore and fifteen souls." (Acts 7:14)
- In reference to part of the inner man, such as "And Mary said,
- My^{*} soul doth magnify the Lord" (Luke 1:46)
- * This shows that the soul is a part of the person.

What are the characteristics of the soul?

It is the seat of a man's personality with 3 components. <u>MIND</u>: "Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits" (Psalm 103:2; see also Deuteronomy 4:9a) <u>WILL</u>: "I will complain in the bitterness of my soul" (Job 7:11b)

EMOTIONS: "My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death" (see Mark 14:34)

Does the 'soul' mean 'breath' or 'life'?

It is <u>obvious</u> from using the proper Bible (the Authorized King James Version) that the soul is not just the 'breath' or life':

- There are Scriptures that show the soul to be separate from the body.
- Many Scriptures relate the soul to mind, will and emotion functions.
- The use of 'my', 'our', 'thy' etc with the soul shows it to be a part of a person.
- There are many Scriptures showing the soul can be affected in good or bad ways that are related to the heart or inner man.

What is the nature of death?

For believers in Christ, the inner man departs as follows:

"For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: Nevertheless to abide in the flesh is more needful for you." (Philippians 1:23,24) "We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord." (2 Corinthians 5:8) "For as the body without the spirit is dead" (James 2:26)

What is the nature of death?

The body without the spirit and soul takes on the appearance of sleep: "And many of them that sleep in the dust* of the earth shall awake [resurrection of the body]" (Daniel 12:2a) "... as her soul was in departing, (for she died) ..." (see Genesis 35:18)

[•] This refutes the false doctrine of "soul sleep".

SPECIAL NOTE

Many modern 'bible' versions destroy the proper doctrine of the soul, such as in the following: The TRUE says: "And it came to pass, as her soul was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name Benoni" (Genesis ^{35:18a, KJB)} The FALSE says: "As she breathed her last—for she was dying—

she named her son Ben-Oni." (Genesis 35:18a, NIV)

SPECIAL NOTE

Many modern 'bible' versions destroy the proper doctrine of the soul, such as in the following: The TRUE says: "And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived." (1 Kings 17:22, KJB) The FALSE says: "The Lord answered Elijah's prayer, and the boy started breathing again." (1 Kings 17:22, CEV)

SPECIAL NOTE

Many modern 'bible' versions destroy the proper doctrine of the soul, such as in the following: The TRUE says: "He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light." (Job 33:28, KJB) The FALSE says: "God has delivered me from going down to the pit, and I shall live to enjoy the light of life." (Job 33:28, NIV)

Is there healing for the soul?

"I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee." (Psalm 41:4) "He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake." (Psalm 23:3)



What is salvation of the soul?

"But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to <u>the saving of the soul</u>." (Hebrews 10:39) "Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to <u>save your souls</u>." (James 1:21)

"yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: Receiving the end of your faith, even <u>the salvation of your souls</u>." (1 Peter 1:8,9)

What is salvation of the soul?

Salvation of the soul = the soul (mind, will and emotions) is changed to conform to Christ.

It is washed by the water of the Word of God and obedience to it (see Ephesians 5:26 & 1 Peter 1:22).

It is renewed to be separate from the world's ways of thinking (see Romans 12:2).

It is prospered in Christ (see 3 John 2).
